UNBOXING STEM PROFESSIONS: A DAY IN THE LIFE OF WOMEN IN SCIENCE

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) will celebrate the International Day of Women and Girls in Science through a hybrid Career Planning Forum titled Unboxing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Professions: A Day in the Life of Women in Science on February 11, 2025, at the DOST-Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) Auditorium, Diliman, Quezon City, and via Zoom online platform and Facebook Live.

The event will feature inspiring stories from visionary and exemplary women in STEM who will boost the learners' confidence and unlock endless opportunities in the world of science, technology, and innovation.

This hybrid activity aims to achieve the following specific objectives:

1. Recognize the important contribution of women in various STEM fields;
2. Introduce and provide background on various STEM fields to Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners through the experiences of women experts; and
