The softcopy of the primer and concept paper for Karibok ang Tuktok is sent to your email.



CONCEPT PAPER



Karibok ang Tuktok (KAT) 2025 is an academic competition organized by the University of the Philippines Batangan. Composed of contests such as quiz bee, essay writing, impromptu speaking, poster making, photo essay, and short filmmaking, this competition aims to promote the academic excellence of the students of the province of Batangas. With the theme "Walang Kasarian ang Barako: Pagpapakatotoo sa Identidad ay Sukatan ng Tapang at Dignidad," KAT is celebrating its 44th year and advancing gender equality for social and economic development through the participation of youth in breaking gender barriers, stereotypes, and biases.

In a patriarchal society, a system that unfairly privileges men, the women and LGBTQ+ community are often marginalized. A set of expectations are formed, enclosing women inside a box that impose a limited number of roles they can perform. In the World Economic Forum's (WEF) 2025 Global Gender Gap Report, the country's efforts to eliminate gender barriers were manifested as it reclaimed a spot in the global top 20, reflecting the increasing work opportunities and participation for women (Philippine Commission on Women, 2025). While this is a good indicator of how the gender culture in the society has progressed, the LGBTQ+ community remains neglected, with the SOGIE bill once again sidelined (Catequista, 2025). Discrimination, bullying, and harassment are consistently experienced by LGBTQ+ individuals in cultural contexts where all genders other than men are othered and oppressed. A society that fails to show inclusivity poses a threat to the freedom to express and self-identify. With youth participation and their capacity to create a positive impact, gender equality becomes a hopeful possibility.



The role of *Karibok ang Tuktok*, as an event that gathers youth to foster knowledge development and broaden perspectives, becomes even more significant when pressing issues such as social justice is concerned. It provides an opportunity to motivate many young people to get involved in transforming the gender ideologies that perpetuate gender disparities in economic, educational, political, and health spheres. By strengthening voices and empowering youth to challenge gender-based discrimination, a community rooted in equality is shaped. This aligns with the gender equality agenda of the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) that seeks to recognize the rights of all individuals regardless of gender and unlock their full potential in forwarding national growth. Without the stereotypes and biases, everyone can be given equal opportunities for leadership and decision-making roles, allowing higher representation and participation in political positions—an essential for high levels of inclusion where respect, dignity, and safety are rightfully upheld.

Leadership, economic empowerment, and action on ending violence are the pillars of the Youth and Gender Equality Strategy, a solution carried out through the collaboration of young men and women (United Nations, 2025). The way youth assert their role and power in changing the traditional gender narratives from being restrictive to liberating is only one way they can reduce the gender gap. By fostering a new culture free from discrimination, the world can move further into resolving poverty, inequality, and violence while creating a safe and supportive environment where young people have the freedom to express themselves and are equally respected.



The actions and efforts done today shape the reality of young people's future. Engaging them on gender issues across all aspects empowers them to reconstruct a more progressive society where rights are recognized and upheld. Through *KAT 2025*, a platform is born where youth unite to advocate for gender equality and empowerment, bringing the goal towards sustainable development closer to reality.

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




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About UP Batangan
