### Quiz Bee Mechanics

1. Each school must send a team of five (5) quizzers to participate in the event. Teams with fewer than five (5) participants will be disqualified. All quizzers must be officially enrolled for the School Year 2025-2026 and must be part of the HUMSS Strand. The deadline for submitting your entries is February 17, 2026. Please send your entries to <https://forms.gle/TS2sPGhpzfKqXhj9> / [4th Inter-Senior High School General Information Quiz Bee-MANILA](#).
2. All participants are expected to be at the venue at 12:00 in the afternoon for a short contest briefing.
3. The quiz bee will cover International Affairs, Politics, Literature, Geography, Entertainment, Natural Science, Sports, Arts, World History, and Philippine History.
4. The 4th Inter-Senior High School General Information Quiz Bee will consist of three rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult. The point distribution for each round is as follows: two points for the Easy round, three points for the Average round, and five points for the Difficult round. In the event of a tie, tiebreaker questions will be provided.
5. In the easy round, participants are given twenty (20) seconds to answer, twenty-five (25) seconds in the average round, and thirty (30) seconds in the difficult round.
6. The quiz bee will use the **Quizizz App**. Each team must bring a laptop or tablet. Only one laptop or tablet will be used for the competition.
7. To raise a protest, any team member must raise their right hand before the quizmaster reads the next question. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the right to protest and acceptance of the given answer(s).
8. A cash prize of P10,000, along with medals and certificates, will be awarded to the Champion. The First Runner-Up will receive a cash prize of P7,000, as well as medals and certificates. The Second Runner-Up will be awarded P5,000 in cash, along with medals and certificates. The Third Runner-Up will receive P3,000 in cash, along with medals and certificates. Additionally, all non-winning teams will receive certificates for their participation, as will their coaches.
9. Along with cash prizes, medals, and certificates, the Champion, First Runner-Up, and Second Runner-Up will also receive the following scholarship grants as additional prizes:

Contest Rank	Prize Package for Winners
CHAMPION (Group of Five Members)	100% Scholarship Tuition Fee Only + Cash + Medal + Certificate
FIRST RUNNER UP (Group of Five Members)	75% Scholarship Tuition Fee Only + Cash + Medal + Certificate
SECOND RUNNER UP (Group of Five Members)	50% Scholarship Tuition Fee Only + Cash + Medal + Certificate
