- 6. Human Development and Wellness






Abstract Submission Guidelines

The 2nd Dasmariñas Research Congress invites all senior high students, faculty members, professional researchers, and research enthusiasts who are residing INSIDE OR OUTSIDE the City of Dasmariñas to present their papers, discuss their experiences, share new ideas and results, and converse any practical challenges they encountered in their research engagements at this conference.

Abstract Content Guidelines:

The abstract to be submitted must strictly adhere to the general guidelines below:

- 1. All research contributions must be original and not presented elsewhere.
- 2.The research abstract must consist of 200-250 words only with a maximum of 6 keywords.
- 3. The research abstract must contain the following: (1) introduction; (2) objectives; (3) methodology; (4) results and discussion; and (5) conclusion and recommendations.
- 4. Include the following details prior to the abstract part: (1) title of the study; (2) researchers' complete names with current positions and affiliations; and (3) email address of the corresponding author.

5. General Format:

Font Text: Open Sans Font Size: 12

A4 Paper Size Margins: 1 inch all side Justified Text (all paragraphs)
