Sample LCSC Activities with Brief Descriptions

ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
1. <i>Life in Christ Seminar</i>	A one-day integrated course which leads participants into a renewed understanding of God's call to them as Christians, and start living a spirit-filled Christian life, through prayers, teachings, sacred music, group discussions and fellowship.
2. <i>LIVE LIFE Forum</i>	Focuses on the sacredness of life and the importance of family as God's valuable gift, the true, good and beautiful plans of God for us, and the issues and realities in the world today that create false ideas about faith, family and life.
3. <i>MENTAL HEALTH Forum</i>	Discusses what mental health is and the issues surrounding it, to help combat depression and anxiety, and prevent suicidal tendencies among young and old.
4. <i>PARENT's Forum</i>	Inspires parents to better relate with their children and take on their responsibility in guiding the young to chastity, as they gain a deeper perspective of the current generation.
5. <i>CHASTITY Forum</i>	Promotes SAVED sex rather than SAFE sex and equips the participants with the right information about teen sexuality focused on being pure and chaste before God's eyes that is, how our sexuality works perfectly with God's plan.
6. <i>MEN & WOMEN's Forum</i>	Guides the young on how to be men and women that God wants them to become, and builds among young people genuine brotherhood and sisterhood, as system of deep friendships anchored on loyalty, accountability and mutual respect.
7. <i>LOVE Forum</i>	Informs young men and women on ; how genuine love should be based on the scriptures, practical tips young people can live by the mean time while waiting for true love, and misconceptions about love as translated by the world and media today.
8. <i>Live the Faith Series</i>	Proclaims the Gospel of Catholicity by educating, forming and inspiring Catholics to know, love and defend their faith.
9. <i>Liturgical Bible Study</i>	Involves reading, understanding and reflecting on Sunday Mass Readings (Gospel, First Reading & Second Reading) to get the central message, ending up with an agreed upon challenge to be acted on and truly make God's Word alive.
