There are various steps to mitigate the impacts of disasters within which agencies and offices can invest on such as focusing on the preservation of digital copies, creating back-up copies, implementing climate-resilient infrastructure, providing secure storage both for physical and digital archives, and foremost, training personnel on emergency procedures. These steps are essential to minimize the potential damage of disasters such as water and fire.

In line with this, we are cordially inviting Local Chief Executives, Records Officers, Records Administrators, Records Custodians, Archivists, Administrative Officers, Administrative Assistants/Staff, and other personnel, be it from the National Government Agencies, Local Government Units, State Colleges and Universities, who are involved in the records management program of their respective offices.
