As part of the university's commitment to environmental initiatives, the Social Innovation Research Center (SIRC) and Extension Service Office-Central will be holding the first ever INDAC para sa Calumpang Summit (Interdisciplinary Networking and Discussion Across Fields for Calumpang Summit in September 2025.

As an educational institution, BatStateU's INDAC para sa Calumpang shall serve as convener of discussions among local government units, education professionals and other related stakeholders on the current state and importance of the watershed to the province.
