2. OBAS CONTENT

THEME: LET THE WRITTEN WORDS COME TO LIFE (Area: Philippine Literature in English and Filipino)

The Quiz Bee will be based on the book authored by Bienvenido Lumbera and Cynthia Nograles Lumbera, *Philippine Literature: A History and Anthology*

The chapter reference per curriculum level follows:

Grades 4 to 6

The Pre-Colonial Period & Short Story

Chapter 1

Oral Lore from Precolonial Times

Grades 7 to 10

The Colonial Period & Essays-Poetry

Chapter 2 Chapter 3 Literature under Spanish Colonialism Literature under US Colonialism

Grades 11 to 12

The Republic and Post-EDSA Period & Novels-Plays

Chapter 4

Literature under the Republic

Chapter 5

Literature after EDSA

Note: For the Quiz Bee, the main reference would be the History segment of the indicated Lumbera chapters and two or three **pre-announced** selections from the Anthology of the same chapters.

Depending on the number of registered participants, the Quiz Bee elimination round (11 October) will have two rounds of 15 to 20 questions each per sector, from the combined History segment and two to three pre-announced Anthology selections. The finals shall have 20 to 30 questions of one or two rounds.

3. ART SUMMIT RUBRICS

The Art Summit events below are to be taken freely from the corresponding literary works:

The three events below shall have an elimination round, the rubrics and mechanics of which would depend on the number of registrants.

Choral Singing (original composition taken from a literary piece)

Chorale Recitation (Sabayang Bigkas) (any segment taken from one of the designated literary piece)

Declamation or Oratorical Contest (any segment taken from one of the designated literary piece)

The two events below would most probably have no more elimination round. The student entries would execute their work, say, in two to three hours, on-the-spot in an assigned room.

Poster Sketching on a scene from a select literary piece
Diorama on the Family from a selection of literary piece characters (creative)

4. FINALS DAY

The Finals Day of the QBSA will probably have the following schedule:

There shall be two finalists per curriculum level involved. The finals, whose rubrics are still to be made definitive, could be held one after another in a hall or in separate rooms.

(ES, JHS, SHS - 3 per team)

Oxford-Oregon Debate on socio-political issues

(JHS, SHS - 3 per side from opposing clusters of schools or from two opposing schools)
