We are pleased to present the following **SYL Leadership Programs for School Year 2026–2027**, which may be conducted in partnership with your Schools Division Office:

1. Division-Wide Student Leadership Development Program

This three-day intensive leadership training is designed for (1) **Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG/SPG)** and **Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG/SSG)** officers. (2) **Leadership Development Training for Non-Leaders** for those students who are not in the Student Government and who are interested to develop their leadership skills. Co-hosted with the Schools Division Office, the program empowers young leaders through interactive and problem-based learning experiences focused on:

- Leadership and influence
- Ethical decision-making
- Balance and personal effectiveness
- Character formation and responsible citizenship
- Teamwork and service leadership

Registration Fee: Php 500 per participant

Venue: To be determined by the Schools Division Office

2. Faculty Leadership and Professional Development Program

Executive Leadership Development Program for School Heads and Teachers: *Leading Schools in a Changing World: Leadership, Courage, Values, and 21st Century Skills.*

Key learning areas include:

- Conflict Resolution and Consensus Building
- Decision-Making and Leadership Balance
- Socratic Dialogue and Critical Thinking
- Intelligence, Skills, and Values of Effective Educators
- Team Effectiveness and Collaborative Leadership
- Health and Wellness Leadership

Registration Fee: Php 500 per participant

3. Philippine Leadership Congress (TBA)

The **Philippine Leadership Congress** is a three-day national gathering that brings together student leaders from different schools and regions of the country.

The Congress seeks to empower participants to become confident, values-driven, and future-ready leaders by engaging them in:

- Leadership forums and discussions
- Dialogues with distinguished Filipino leaders and professionals
- Visits to government institutions
- Networking and collaboration opportunities
- Personal leadership reflection and action planning

The program aims to inspire young leaders to become active contributors to a safer, stronger, and more progressive Philippines.

4. National Summer Leadership Camp 2027

Recognized as one of the longest-running leadership camps in the Philippines, the **National Summer Leadership Camp (NSLC)** provides participants with a transformative learning experience grounded in reflection, experiential learning, and practical leadership application. This is conducted in Dumaguete City, Philippines, every April of the year.

Participants are guided to discover and develop their leadership potential through their own life experiences while deepening their understanding of leadership principles, character formation, and service.

Registration Fee: Php 7,500 per participant
Venue: Dumaguete City, Philippines (every April of the year)

5. SYL International Leadership and Educational Exchange Programs

The SYL International Programs are designed to develop globally aware and socially responsible leaders by exposing participants to different cultures, educational systems, governance models, and socio-economic realities.

Through institutional visits, leadership dialogues, cultural immersion, and engagement with international stakeholders, participants gain a deeper appreciation of regional and global issues and their implications for the future of the Philippines.

- **SIPA Singapore** – October 25–30, 2026
- **SYL European Leadership Program** – November 1–15, 2026
- **SIPA Japan** – November 22-27, 2026
- **SYL New Zealand Program** – January 24–31, 2027
- **SYL Europe Program** – May 1–15, 2027
- **SIPA Brunei**- May 18-23, 2027
