In line with existing Department of Education policies, all concerned are hereby reminded of the following:

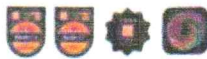
1. Participation in or accommodation of activities initiated by private organizations, including Lyceum of the Philippines University-Batangas shall not be interpreted as official endorsement by the Department.
2. Consistent with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (Child Protection Policy), any participation of learners must be Strictly voluntary; With written parental/guardian consent; and Free from coercion or undue influence.
3. Activities organized by external groups shall not disrupt regular classes or diminish instructional time in line with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 (Time-on-Task Policy)
4. Further, in line with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, otherwise known as the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education, teachers shall not be interrupted during actual class hours to ensure the continuity of teaching and learning.
5. All field offices and schools are advised to exercise due diligence and ensure that any engagement with Lyceum of the Philippines University-Batangas, or similar organizations strictly complies with DepEd policies and prioritizes the best interest of learners.
