Short contests	A series of six educational short contests will be held from 2:00–4:00 p.m. on the six Saturdays from November 11 to December 16, 2023. Community discussion and written tutorials will follow after each contest.
Long contest	A culminating long contest will then be held from December 23, 2023, to January 1, 2024, following the same format as the NOI.PH Eliminations Round.
