**READING LITERACY ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM
IN FILIPINO & ENGLISH FOR ELEMENTARY LEVEL
SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024**



1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 45, s. 2002, titled "No Read, No Pass Policy in All Public Schools", this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the enforcement of this order both in Filipino and English for S.Y 2023-2024 particularly to Grade 3 pupils.
2. The program aims to:
 - a. provide meaningful literacy enhancement and interventions that cater both the struggling and independent readers.
 - b. reduce the number of frustration readers through systematic and targeted competency based and school reading interventions.
 - c. attain the zero non-reader in all public elementary level within the division.
3. For Grade Three (3) pupil to be promoted to Grade Four (4), the learner should be able to read both in English and Filipino.
4. It is the role of the teacher and the school head to follow the DepEd's policy with the aim of helping pupils to become independent readers.
5. Similarly, one objective in the Enhanced Education Act of 2013 is to ensure that all students are successful readers under the "Every Child a Reader Program" or ECARP designed for elementary pupils to be independent young readers and writers.



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6. Furthermore, to ensure the full implementation, a cluster monitoring of this reading activity shall be started on the first week of the third quarter.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is highly directed.
