- 1. This Schools Division, in coordination with the Provincial Government of Batangas, announces the mechanics regarding the selection of the would-be scholars in Batangas Province High School for Culture and Arts, Provincial Sports Complex, Bolbok, Batangas City for the School Year 2023-2024.
- 2. The entrance examination will be composed of three phases.
 - Phase I Written Examination. All applicants who passed the a. preliminary screening shall be allowed to take this test.
 - Phase II Performance Test (Field of interest i.e., Music, Visual b. Arts, Dance, Theater Arts, Creative Writing)
 - Phase III Interview. All examinees shall be given interview. C.

Only examinees who undergo the three phases shall be ranked according to the following:

3. The Entrance Examination shall be held at the Tanghalang Rosela, Batangas Province High School for Culture and Arts, Bolbok, Batangas City on May 25, 2023 (Thursday). Phases I, II and III shall be conducted on the same date:

1:00 - 3:00 PM

- 4. The candidates for admission are the elementary school graduates for School Year 2023-2024 who have demonstrated talent and potential in the Arts, with an average of 85% and a final rating of 85% in MSEP, FILIPINO and ENGLISH in the Third Grading Period.
- 5. All applicants shall be required to register and submit the documents below on or before **May 8, 2023**:
 - a. Photocopy of Form 138-E* certified true and correct by the principal
 - b. Certificate of Good Moral Character
 - c. Elementary School ID with picture duly signed by the Principal
 - d. Certification re: chosen field of interest and proof of excellence along this line duly signed by the School Principal
 - e. Certificate of Residency duly signed by the Barangay Chairman
 - f. Medical Certificate
- 6. A maximum number of 35 scholars shall be chosen through ranking system. There shall be separate ranking per municipality and the examinee who ranks first from each municipality shall be chosen as BPHSCA Young Arts scholar. Only those examinees who obtained a rating of 85% above shall be ranked. In case that there is no applicant in some municipalities, the next applicants in the overall ranking shall be chosen regardless of his address.

- 1. Acting ability

- 3. Voice projection

• Practical Test - 1/4 illustration board, oil pastel, drawing materials

Standard Criteria

- 1. Choice of subject, symbolism, message
- 2. Elements/principles of design
