# CONDUCT OF SCHOOL/DISTRICT/DIVISION MONITORING EVALUATION AND PLAN ADJUSTMENTS FOR 2nd QUARTER OF FISCAL YEAR 2022 (1st - 3<sup>rd</sup> QUARTER OF SY 2021-2022)

- To track the status of program implementation contributing to improve the quality of basic education and to ensure the operation of the curriculum support systems for SY 2021-2022, SDO Batangas through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) shall once again hold Monitoring Evaluation Plan Adjustments (MEPA) activities in various levels:
  - a. School Monitoring Evaluation Plan Adjustments (SMEPA)
  - b. District Monitoring Evaluation Plan Adjustments (DsMEPA)
  - c. Division Monitoring Plan Adjustments (DMEPA)
- 2. The activity aims to provide necessary data and information as important inputs in decision-making to continuously improve the following:
  - a. Organizational Performance for efficient and effective delivery of basic education services as well as the mandates of the Department;
  - Implementation of PPAs at various governance levels to achieve the desired output and sustainability of education outcomes;
  - c. Organizational health and performance which serve as basis in determining appropriate strategies and interventions to improve organizational effectiveness, efficiency and resource support.
- 3. Moreover, the conduct of DMEPA activities are expected to provide necessary data in relation to the implementation of school-based programs and projects and other programs mandated by the national government, as well as school-based initiated interventions in addressing the gaps and for continuous improvement.
- 4. This shall also serve as data collection activity to monitor the quarterly progress of different PPAs and will serve as a facility to establish school/district data bank.

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5. In this regard, all schools and districts are requested to simultaneously conduct the MEPA activities either virtually or face to face on the following dates:

- School heads are expected to present their accomplishment during the SMEPA with the presence of their teachers, SGC, PTA, student representative and other stakeholders.
- 7. The Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) are requested to facilitate the conduct of the DsMEPA in their respective districts.
- 8. The quarterly themes shall focus on Access, Quality, and Governance.
- The SMEPA/DsMEPA report shall include the following salient points: Program Implementation (Access, Quality and Governance)
  - I. Over-all physical accomplishments and utilization of each program
  - II. Over-all School Performance
  - III. Agenda Affecting Program design, policy, standard system and TA needed
    - a. Access
      - 1. Enrolment per Key Stage (based on 1st -3rd Quarter)
      - 2. Dropout (based on 1st -3rd Quarter)
      - 3. PPAs physical accomplishments (Target vs Actual) and Impact
    - b. Quality
      - 1. Failures and Achievement per learning area (based on 1st -3rd Quarter)
      - 2. PPAs physical accomplishments (Target vs Actual)
    - c. Governance
      - 1. PPAs physical accomplishments (target vs. actual)
      - 2. Implementation gaps/issues
      - 3. Best practices
- 10. PSDSs shall present the consolidated findings during the DMEPA using the following presentation flow:
  - a. Access
    - 1. Consolidated Enrolment per Key Stage (1st-3rd Quarter)
    - 2. Consolidated Dropout (1st-3rd Quarter)
    - 3. Consolidated PPAs physical accomplishments (Target vs Actual)

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- b. Quality
  - Consolidated Failures and Achievement per learning area and per Key Stage (based on 1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter)
  - 2. Consolidated PPAs physical accomplishments (Target vs Actual)
- c. Governance
  - 1. Consolidated PPAs physical accomplishments (target vs. actual)
  - 2. Consolidated Implementation gaps/issues (if any)
  - 3. Consolidated Best practices from selected schools
- 11. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against School/Division MOOE and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 12. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
