1. Relative to Division Memorandum No. 732, s. 2025, re: **Division Climate Change Conference**, with the theme “One Planet, One Climate”, this Office hereby informs all concerned that the said conference shall be finally conducted on March 12–13, 2026 at Rosario Resort and Hotel, Brgy. Quilib, Rosario, Batangas. In this regard, the elected secondary student officers of the Sub-Office Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Student Organization, together with their respective faculty advisers, are hereby authorized to participate in the said activity.
2. The participation of the identified student leaders and their advisers aim to strengthen youth engagement in climate action initiatives and to enhance their knowledge and capacity on climate change adaptation and mitigation, in alignment with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9729, otherwise known as the Climate Change Act of 2009.
3. Each Sub-Office shall send five (5) student officers and one (1) faculty adviser to attend the conference. Pre-registration shall be accomplished through the link to be provided to the respective Sub-Office DRRM Focal Persons. Learner- participants are reminded to secure a **parent’s permit** prior to joining the activity. This document shall be presented during registration at the venue.
4. In addition, a special session for the Election of Officers of the Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Student Organization shall be conducted during the conference.
5. Selected members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) are required to attend Day 0 (*pre-implementation or preparatory day*) of the activity. Should Day 0 fall on a non-working holiday, concerned personnel shall be granted compensatory time-off (CTO) or service credits, as applicable, subject to existing Civil Service Commission (CSC) and DepEd policies, rules, and regulations.
