**ADMINISTRATION OF THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LITERACY AND
NUMERACY ASSESSMENT (SHS LNA) FOR GRADE 11 LEARNERS,
SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 016, s. 2026 dated March 4, 2026, the Senior High School Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (SHS LNA) will be administered to all Grade 11 learners enrolled in **public** and **private senior high schools** in the Schools Division of Batangas for School Year 2025-2026.
2. The primary aim of this assessment is to measure learners' proficiency in foundational literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for their academic advancement and career readiness, while also providing data to inform targeted interventions designed to enhance teaching and learning practices across all schools.
3. The assessment window is set for March 16–20 2026, with specific dates per school to be finalized by the focal persons preferably those in charge for administering the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI), Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA), and Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA).
4. Schools are required to schedule all assessments during regular class hours and must avoid conflicts with other major school activities such as graduation preparations, sports events, or regional competitions.
5. The assessment consists of two core components: **Literacy**, which covers reading comprehension, writing skills, critical thinking, and effective communication across various text types including academic articles, technical documents, and creative pieces; and **Numeracy**, which focuses on problem-solving, data interpretation, mathematical reasoning, and the practical application of concepts in real-world contexts such as financial planning, measurement, and statistical analysis.
6. School Heads will oversee overall implementation, ensure full compliance with all guidelines. See Enclosure 1 list of Division Monitoring Officials.
