**SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDELINES ON THE 3rd BATCH OF SCHOOL-BASED
FEEDING PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION SY 2023-2024**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No.39 s. 2017 and Regional Memorandum No. 229 s. 2023, the Department of Education (DepEd), Schools Division of Batangas thru the SGOD-Health and Nutrition shall continue to implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for SY 2023-2024.
2. The beneficiaries of the program are the severely wasted, wasted learners, the severely stunted, stunted and indigent learners from public elementary schools, Kinder to Grade VI Learners. SBFP -Nutritious Food Product (NFP) will be served for 60 to 120 feeding days. Double feeding, including Saturday and Sundays, will be conducted to complete the target feeding days.
3. The third batch of implementation will start on April 2, 2024 until May 31, 2024 for Congressional District 2.
4. In compliance with DepEd Order 2, s. 2024 – Immediate Removal of Administrative Tasks of Public School Teacher, all Drop Off Points shall update and submit a copy of Authorized Consignees, School/Sub-Office Inspection Team (SBFP Form 4) and scanned copy of their IDs with three (3) specimen signature to SGOD-Health and Nutrition Section Unit.
5. School heads are requested to submit Work and Financial Plan for Operating Expenses for the approval of the SDO Top Management.
6. Attached are the List of Drop-Off Points, Schedule of Deliveries, Summary of Quantity Breakdown and SBFP Form 4 for reference.
7. All activities to be conducted by the school shall comply with the required health standards as stipulated on DepEd Order No. 14 s. 2020 or the Guidelines on the Required Health Standard in Basic Education Offices and Schools.
