1. The **National Festival of Talents (NFOT)** serves as a premier platform for Filipino learners to showcase their skills, creativity, and innovation across various disciplines, aligning with the Department of Education's commitment to holistic development and excellence. This annual event fosters a culture of competence and collaboration, celebrating learners' talents across all specialized fields and learning areas. Set to take place in **Vigan City, Region 1, from May 19 to 23, 2025**, NFOT 2025 emphasizes the integration of 21st-century skills, Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS), and digital resiliency, equipping participants for global competitiveness while preserving local cultural heritage. Through competitions and exhibitions, the festival not only highlights learners' achievements but also nurtures the values of perseverance, innovation, and national pride, reinforcing education's role in shaping future-ready Filipinos.
2. In preparation for this event, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) of this Schools Division will conduct a **Division Training Workshop for NFOT 2025 Qualifiers** from **April 10-11, April 21-26, April 28-30, May 5-10, and May 14-16, 2025**, at **San Nicolas Integrated National High School, San Nicolas Sub-Office, San Nicolas, Batangas**. As a co-curricular activity, participation in NFOT serves as a proactive reinforcement of the teaching and learning process, bridging classroom knowledge with real-world applications.
3. This training workshop aims to provide intensive training and equip qualifiers with the necessary skills, confidence, and excellence to perform at their highest potential—bringing pride and honor to the province of Batangas in the upcoming national competition. Specifically, its main objectives are -
 - 3.1 to provide intensive training and skill enhancement in the specific talent categories where students have qualified, ensuring they meet national standards of excellence.



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- 3.2 to strengthen participants' preparedness through structured practice sessions, mock competitions, and constructive feedback from experienced trainers and mentors.
- 3.3 to build confidence and boost morale by equipping participants with the essential tools, techniques, and strategies to excel in their respective fields.
- 3.4 to foster camaraderie and collaboration among qualifiers, promoting the exchange of ideas, experiences, and best practices.
- 3.5 to ensure the readiness of SDO Batangas Province qualifiers for the 2025 National Festival of Talents (NFOT), maximizing their potential for success in the national competition.
4. Necessary materials, ingredients, tools and equipment shall be brought by the participants during the training – workshop.
5. The food of the participants shall be charged against the Provincial School Board's Special Education Fund, while the incidental and other expenses of the participants relating to this activity shall be charged to the school/local/Special Education Funds (SEF), whichever is applicable. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
