- 1. In reference to Regional Advisory No. 32, s. 2025, DM-OUHROD-2025-0409, and the invitation letter from the Department of Science and Technology Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (DOST-PHIVOLCS), this Office informs all concerned of the conduct of the Training on Communicating Volcano, Earthquake, and Tsunami Hazards for Junior High School Teachers, scheduled on June 9–11, 2025, at Brentwood Suites Hotel, Quezon City.

Participants' travel expenses shall be charged against school MOOE, local funds, or any available sources, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.




