IMPLEMENTATION OF UNIFIED SUBJECTS FOR GRADE 12 (OLD CURRICULUM ADJUSTED TO THE 3-TERM CALENDAR FOR SY 2026-2027)

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Chief-Curriculum Implementation Division (CID)
Chief-School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD)
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public and Private Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. In line with the continuing efforts to strengthen curriculum alignment and ensure consistency in the delivery of instruction, this Office informs all concerned of the implementation of the Unified Subjects for Grade 12.
2. Enclosed in this issuance is the Unified Subjects adjusted to the 3-Term Calendar, which shall serve as reference and guide for all Senior High School implementers (old curriculum).
3. Schools are hereby provided with the following options:
 - a. **Priority Option: Full Adoption of the Unified Subject Scheme**
Schools are highly encouraged to adopt the prescribed unified subject scheme for Grade 12 to:
 - promote uniformity in teaching and learning processes;
 - ensure alignment with curriculum standards and competencies; and
 - facilitate efficient planning, monitoring, and evaluation.
 - b. **Alternative Option: Contextualized Adjustments**
Schools that encounter unavoidable and school-specific circumstances may implement necessary adjustments to the unified subjects, provided that:
 - such adjustments are based on valid and justifiable conditions (e.g., teacher specialization, available resources, class organization);
 - alignment with the intent and core competencies of the unified subject scheme is maintained; and
 - modifications are properly documented and subject to review/approval by the appropriate authority.
4. All school heads are directed to assess their respective contexts and ensure that the selected option prioritizes quality instruction and learner outcomes. Adoption of the unified subject scheme remains the preferred approach.
