#### STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. All works submitted shall be unpublished and have not been entered in other competitions.
- 2. Stories must be original. Adaptation and unique retelling of local stories may be done with respect and sensibility.
- 3. Artworks and texts produced through artificial intelligence (AI) or similar system-generated concepts shall NOT be used in any part of the entries.
- 4. Stories must be written in FILIPINO
- 5. Stories must be based on one or a combination of learning competencies in any learning area/s of MATATAG Curriculum.
- 6. Stories shall contain the themes and motifs of tradition, culture, environment, art, and a basic understanding of local concepts.
- 7. There shall be no accompanying processing questions and supplementary activities in the story.
- 8. It must follow Ortograpiyang Pambansa published by the Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino. For other styling concerns, follow the Chicago Manual of Style 17<sup>th</sup> Edition.
- 9. For a wordless storybook, only one (1) word is allowed in the entire storybook. Only one creator is allowed in the Wordless storybook serving as the writer and the illustrator.
- 10. The following are the specifications for manuscript submission:
  - a. The number of words for Grades 1,2 and 3 must not exceed 2000.
  - b. The number of words for Grades 4, 5, and 6 must not exceed 5,000.
  - c. All entries must be typed in MS Word using any serif typefaces in single space, size 12.
  - d. The learning competencies covered shall be placed in the last part of the manuscript, written in italics and flushed right.
