- 2. In light of this, SDO Batangas, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of the Division Science and Technology Fair (DSTF) with the theme "Building Smart and Sustainable Communities" The DSTF Research Congress and Presentation will be held on September 26, 2025, at Baybayin Integrated National High School, Rosario, Batangas.

Similarly, for the Division Technical Working Group, expenses related to food, DSTF materials, travel, and other incidental costs will be covered by Division MOOE funds, also subject to the usual government accounting and auditing guidelines.

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Enclosure 1: General Guidelines on the Conduct of 2025 Division Science and Technology Fair (DSTF)

GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF 2025 DSTF

- 1. The competition is open to Grades 9-12 learners of both public and private high schools in the Division of Batangas who have not reached the age of 20 on or before May 1 of the current school year.
- 2. Learners may work individually or in teams with 2-3 members from the same school. Each learner is only allowed to submit one (1) research project in one (1) of the five (5) research categories: Life Science, Physical Science, Robotics and Intelligent Machines, Mathematics and Computational Sciences, and Science Innovation Expo. The project should include no more than 12 months of continuous research and should not include research activities performed before January of the previous school year.
- 3. Public Schools District Supervisors are requested to submit the soft copies of entries to CID email address at emerson.dalangin@deped.gov.ph on or before September 12, 2025 by 5 p.m., using the designated format found in the handbook. Failure to submit the report and projects on time shall result in the sub-office's disqualification from participating in the division fair. The STF handbook can be accessed at https://bit.ly/SMTF-Handbook for further guidelines and information.
- 4. The documents of the submitted entries in Science and Mathematics will be screened by the Division Scientific Review Committee. The list of qualified entries shall be announced in a separate memorandum.
- 5. The top 3 qualifiers from the initial screening will advance to the Division Science and Technology Fair (DSTF) for the actual validation, showcasing, and screening of the project.
- 6. Participation in this activity is voluntary and no registration fee will be collected.
