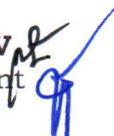

VI.	Brief Description	The Provincial Government of Batangas through the PGENRO in collaboration with MFI will be conducting the Provincial Environmental Youth Camp (Envi Camp) this year 2025 to ignite environmental awareness and empower the next generation of young environmentalists' leaders. The 3-day Envi Camp is designed to discuss the role of the youth in sustainable environment and introduce environmental conservation and protection concepts and strategies through lectures, workshops, games and field exposures that are aimed to develop young stewards for the environment. Participants to the Envi Camp were invited and screened in close coordination with the Local Chief Executive through the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officers (MENRO) and the school Principals. The Envi Camp is open to all aspiring youth environmental leaders who meet the following criteria: • Must be 14 to 17 years old at the time of the camp. • Must be physically fit to participate in outdoor and field-based activities. • Must be a resident of a coastal barangay/municipality within Batangas Province. • Preference will be given to those who are children or immediate relatives of fisherfolk residing near an established marine protected area. • Must be fully committed to attending the entire duration of the camp. • Must demonstrate a genuine interest in environmental conservation. • Should preferably be engaged in community or environmental activities. • Should show potential to become a youth ambassador or advocate for environmental conservation. • Must be willing to share learnings and contribute to environmental initiatives in their school or community after the camp.



	• Must submit duly signed parent/guardian consent form. • Must submit medical certificate from Municipal Health Office or attending Physician stating that the participant is physically fit and have no illness.

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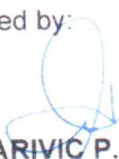
