1. Pursuant to the Joint Memorandum dated July 14, 2026, titled *Notice of Participation of All Sampled Schools in the PISA-Based Test for Schools (PBTS) Philippines and Conduct of School Readiness Audit*, the Schools Division Office (SDO) Batangas, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), announces the deployment of monitoring officials to conduct the School Readiness Audit and validate the preparedness of participating schools for the implementation of the 2026 PISA-Based Test for Schools (PBTS) Philippines. The monitoring shall be conducted from **August 10-13, 2026 and August 24-27, 2026**. This initiative aims to ensure that all sampled schools are adequately prepared and compliant with the requirements and standards set by the Department of Education for the successful conduct of the assessment.
2. The Division Monitoring Officials will visit the schools, evaluate their readiness, and review their plan. They will provide guidance and recommendations to ensure all the necessary steps are taken to meet the assessment's requirements. Public Schools District Supervisors shall oversee the monitoring of their assigned sub-offices.
3. This memorandum serves as a Travel Order. Attached herewith is the list of schools and monitoring officials.
4. Transportation expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against Division MOOE funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

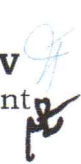

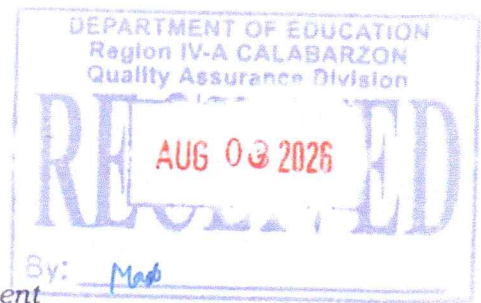

THE PISA-BASED TEST FOR SCHOOLS (PBTS) PHILIPPINES
AND CONDUCT OF SCHOOL READINESS AUDIT**

DATE : **July 14, 2026**

Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2017, titled *Policy Guidelines on System Assessment in the K to 12 Basic Education Program*, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Monitoring and Evaluation Office (MEO), shall administer the PISA-Based Test for Schools (PBTS) 2026. Accordingly, this Office announces the participation of one hundred ninety-eight (198) public and private secondary schools selected to represent the country in the upcoming PISA for Schools cycle.

The sampled schools were drawn and provided by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) using probabilistic methods based on DepEd school-level data. The official list of sampled schools is attached as **Annex A** for reference.

In preparation for the PBTS implementation, all sampled schools shall strictly adhere to the following activities:

The conduct of the PISA for Schools project rests on the following minimum technical and operational requirements:

- a. **Student Sampling Requirement:** Each school shall ensure the participation of fifty-six (56) eligible students whose ages range from 15 years old and three months to 16 years old and 2 months from the list of all currently enrolled learners for the school year.
- b. **Internet Connectivity:** A stable internet connection with a minimum dedicated bandwidth of 10 Mbps that can simultaneously accommodate 56 computers per active testing terminal shall be maintained during all testing sessions.
- c. **Hardware Availability:** A sampled school should have at least a set of conducive rooms that can cater to 56 fully functional, network-ready desktop computers or laptops, including 20 reserve units for technical contingencies.
- d. **Power Redundancy Measures:** School Heads shall ensure the availability and functionality of Generator Sets (GenSets) and/or Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS) to prevent data loss and operational interruptions arising from power outages.

Subject to the approval of the Schools Division Office (SDO), non-sampled public secondary schools with available and functional DepEd Computerization Program (DCP) resources may temporarily lend hardware to sampled schools experiencing equipment shortages. The sampled school may keep custody of the borrowed equipment for a maximum of one week from the date of delivery. The SDO shall facilitate and monitor this resource-sharing arrangement. Meanwhile, the Regional Office (RO) shall provide oversight and technical guidance throughout the process.

The PBTS Technical Team from the DepEd Central Office shall conduct ocular inspections and readiness audits of the sampled schools beginning July 27, 2026, to validate compliance with the prescribed requirements.
