

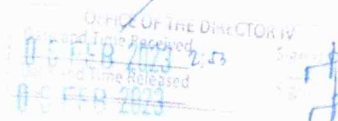

The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations (OUOps) highlights the right of every learner to protection against all forms of violence, abuse, neglect, cruelty, exploitation, and maltreatment, as enshrined in the 1987 Philippine Constitution.

Thus, DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012, otherwise known as the "DepEd Child Protection Policy" was issued as a reiteration of the agency's zero tolerance policy for any act of child exploitation, discrimination, violence and other forms of abuse.

With this, **all regions and divisions are instructed to conduct a coordination meeting with their Philippine National Police (PNP) counterparts regarding petty crimes, self-harm, stabbing, and bullying incidents in schools.**

The agenda is to identify which schools require spot inspections of weapons among learners and personnel. The said spot inspection shall be conducted by school personnel. The PNP shall only provide technical assistance to schools on how this activity shall be conducted. The concerned schools shall be required to submit reports of their action.

Overall, this is a strategy to prevent carrying of deadly weapons and illegal substances inside the school premises.
