
**SEARCH FOR READING RECOGNITION AWARD FOR GRADE 1 AND
GRADE 2 TEACHERS (3RD Year of Implementation)**

1. This Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division resumes the giving of recognition awards to Grade 1 and Grade 2 teachers and to school heads of schools who are exemplifying spectacular outcomes for learners' fluency reading ability.
 2. To iterate, the following are the awards at stake for the performing teachers and school heads in improving learners' reading ability.
 - **Reading Exemplary Award** – for Grade 1 Teachers who were able to produce all learners, well-readers in Filipino
 - **Reading Extra Mile Award** – for Grade 2 Teachers who were able to produce all learners, well-readers in Filipino and English
 - **Reading Advocate Award** – for School Heads who were able to make sure that all learners in Grades 1 and 2 of the school are well-readers.
 3. But for this school year, on its 3rd year of implementation, the search shall be handed over to all Public School District Supervisors (PSDS). The recommendation to collaborate with their respective local government unit through the Municipal Literacy Coordinating Council is highly encouraged for the sake of partnerships concerning with the literacy status of our learners and as the council constituents for a better success of the activity. This is one of the reasons why the activity was transitioned from division-level to district-level.
 4. The teacher-nominee shall be well-screened by the school head and well-validated by the district supervisor, group of school heads within the district and/or with representative from the municipal literacy coordinating council if the district have partnered with the municipal council. The attached nomination form shall be used to formally nominate the teacher by the school head and to nominate the school head by the teacher's association president.



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5. The search shall start from the period of January to March, 2026. A report shall be submitted to the table of the concerned English and Filipino Supervisors on or before the end of the school year; Dr. Miguel B. Ularte and Dr. Loreta V. Ilao, respectively.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
