

1. To demonstrate enhanced understanding, commitment, and capacity to integrate climate change adaptation and mitigation principles into education programs, policies, and school operations, in accordance with *Republic Act No. 9729* (Climate Change Act of 2009), this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division, has scheduled the **Division Climate Change Conference** on December 18-19, 2025, at Rosario Resort and Hotel, Brgy. Quilib, Rosario, Batangas.
2. This activity aims to:
  - a. strengthen awareness and understanding of the science, causes, and local impacts of climate change, particularly its implications for education, school safety, and learner well-being;
  - b. identify and implement climate change adaptation and mitigation strategies within the school context; and
