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CHAMPLI-STAR AND INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC OLYMPIADS PROGRAM 2026

The Champions League for Innovation and Learning Inc. (CHAMPLI) invites Kindergarten to Grade 12 learners from both public and private schools to participate in its CHAMPLI-Students Training for Advanced Readiness (STAR) and International Academic Olympiads Program.

For the academic year 2026, CHAMPLI leads and organizes three major national flagship competitions in the Philippines, collectively known as the CHAMPLI Big Three:

1. International Math Excellence Olympiad,
2. Philippine International Science Olympiad, and
3. Philippine International English Olympiad.

The CHAMPLI-STAR Program is a comprehensive pre-Olympiad preparation and international competition engagement initiative that strengthens Filipino learners' analytical thinking, problem-solving proficiency, academic self-assurance, and global readiness. Through structured review sessions, simulated assessments, and mentor-guided coaching, the program equips students to excel in prestigious international academic Olympiads.

International competitions are conducted online or onsite by CHAMPLI's global partner organizations, while training sessions are facilitated locally by CHAMPLI.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 012, s. 2025, titled Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities and DO 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time- on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
