## 2026 PHILIPPINE GROUP OF LAW LIBRARIANS SUMMER CONFERENCE

The Philippine Group of Law Librarians Inc. (PGLL) will hold its 2026 Summer Conference at Citystate Asturias in Puerto Princesa, Palawan, on May 20–22, 2026.

With the theme, The Quiet Power of Librarians: Innovating Legal Services for the Future-Ready Environment, the Conference will be a gathering of law librarians and legal information professionals in the Philippines with the following objectives:

1. Master prompt engineering and evaluate ethical risks of artificial intelligence use, including hallucinations and liabilities in legal research and citations;
2. Design strategies for sustaining legal information through people, policies, and digital continuity.
3. Apply methods to preserve institutional memory and legal records for future generations; and
4. Develop mentoring programs and ethics practices while managing expectations and burnout in law libraries.
