**INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE ON INNOVATIVE APPROACHES
TO EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT**

MASHAV, Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation of the Embassy of Israel in Manila, invites qualified participants to the International Training Course on Innovative Approaches to Early Childhood Education and Development in Israel from July 5 to 17, 2026.

This training program is organized in collaboration with the University of Haifa's Center for the Study of Child Development and the International Master of Arts Program in Early Education and Development in Early Childhood, School of Therapy, Counseling and Human Development. It offers an interactive learning approach through lectures, study visits, workshops, and discussions.

This course is intended for mid- to senior-level policymakers, professionals, and practitioners in early childhood education and development, including those working in government, nongovernment organizations, academic institutions, and related organizations.

Participants will gain in-depth knowledge of early childhood education and development in Israel, with a focus on innovative approaches and program evaluation. Key topics include early childhood care, socio-emotional development, early intervention, resilience-building, and the use of art, music, and movement therapies, as well as exposure to advanced educational technologies, community service coordination, and field visits to relevant institutions.

Completed application forms, including the health declaration, must be submitted to the Embassy of Israel in Manila no later than June 5, 2026.
