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BRAINGAMES IN MOTION: A MOBILE EDUCATIONAL EXHIBIT

The Kharmela Events Travel and Tours announces the conduct of BrainGames in Motion: A Mobile Educational Exhibit in various schools nationwide for the school year 2026-2027.

BrainGames in Motion is a mobile educational exhibit that brings interactive learning experiences directly to schools. The exhibit features hands-on science, mathematics, psychology, and critical thinking designed to make learning engaging, meaningful, and enjoyable for learners. The program aims to

1. promote experiential and learner-centered education;
2. develop students' critical thinking and problem-solving skills;
3. strengthen scientific inquiry and mathematical reasoning;
4. encourage creativity, collaboration, and communication;
5. increase students' interest in Science, Mathematics, and Psychology; and
6. support the implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum through engaging educational experiences.

The program features two interactive learning modules:

- Module 1: Mind & Motion Challenges engages learners in educational games and physical challenges that demonstrate scientific concepts such as force, motion, gravity, balance, energy transfer, probability, logical reasoning, and teamwork.
- Module 2: Mind Quest allows learners to explore perception, memory, psychology, critical thinking, and decision-making through interactive brain experiments, visual illusions, cognitive challenges, and collaborative activities.

The target participants in this activity are learners in Grades 4–6, junior high school, and senior high school from public and private schools.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.

This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law), issued in DO 19, s. 2008, and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024.
