The Society of Applied Mathematics of the University of the Philippines Los Baños (SAM-UP) will hold Math in Action (MIA) 2027 at Royal Palm Spring Resorts in Bay, Laguna, on February 27-28, 2027.

The MIA 2027: *Laro, Talino, at Kulturang Pilipino!* is a nationwide mathematics camp designed for junior and senior high school learners. The two-day event brings together learners from different schools to participate in a variety of engaging activities that promote a deeper appreciation of mathematics and its applications in everyday life.

The program will feature seminars, lectures, investigatory project presentations, brain teasers, and other interactive learning experiences that foster critical thinking, problem-solving, and collaboration. Through these activities, participants will gain valuable exposure to the practical uses of mathematics, build connections with fellow learners and educators, and develop their creativity, confidence, and academic potential in a fun and supportive environment.
