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SACEDA YOUTH LEAD INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026–2027

The Saceda Youth Lead (SYL) will conduct its various international programs for the school year 2026–2027 in Brunei, Singapore, Australia, the United Arab Emirates, and Europe (Italy, Switzerland, and France). These programs will be held from September 2026 to May 2027.

The international programs aim to

1. study global and regional challenges by examining the common patterns that emerge across cultures and how these patterns reveal the diversity of human experiences, with the goal of mitigating or managing their effects;
2. identify similarities in the impacts of these challenges and study how schools, governments, and leaders can develop and implement viable solutions;
3. foster collaboration and networking among youth leaders and co-leaders;
4. enrich participants' educational experiences through a series of presentations and discussions on global and regional challenges;
5. formulate and develop sustainable solutions to pressing global and regional issues;
6. empower and inspire participants to become future leaders; and
7. promote peace and mutual understanding.

Student leaders from public and private schools, academic scholars, teachers, Sangguniang Kabataan officials, elected public officials, and SYL alumni are invited to participate in these international programs to create one hope, one voice, and one inspiration that will spark transformative changes in educational curricula, political cultures, and socioeconomic approaches.
