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**INVITATION TO THE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE ON CYBER  
AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE FOR GOOD**

MASHAV (Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation) of the Embassy of Israel in Manila invites professionals from the government, private, and third sectors to participate in the International Training Course on Cyber and Artificial Intelligence (AI) for Good. The course will be held at The Golda Meir MASHAV "Carmel" International Training Center in Haifa, Israel, on November 8–20, 2026.

The training program aims to explore how the transformative capabilities of AI and Cybersecurity can be harnessed for positive social impact, contributing to safer, smarter, more sustainable, and equitable communities. Participants will gain practical knowledge and firsthand exposure to Israel's world-renowned innovation ecosystem through expert lectures, interactive discussions, field visits, and networking opportunities. The course highlights include:

- Introduction to the Israeli Cyber and AI Ecosystem;
- AI Applications for Social Good;
- Ethical Considerations in AI and Cybersecurity;
- Cybersecurity Strategies for Protecting Communities;
- Educational Visits to Leading Universities and Innovation Accelerators;
- Site Visits to Technology Companies and Non-Profit Organizations; and
- Participation in AI and Cyber Week Events at Tel Aviv University.

Eligible applicants include directors, managers, entrepreneurs, innovators, and professionals from social institutions, accelerators, and incubators who have demonstrated experience in or a strong aspiration for social impact.
