Event Station	Description
Stargate Theater	An immersive experience of the universe inside a mobile inflatable dome with a breathtaking 180° field of view full-sky coverage of the day and night sky and outer space, featuring galaxies, planets, stars, and constellations. Accompanied by an astronomy-related presentation and lecture discussion.
Planetary Parade	An exhibit station featuring a massive display of the planets, extensive infographics, and diverse science educational materials and exhibits. Accompanied by a lecture discussion.
Mind Craft	Highly engaging and interactive educational activities where learners solve subject-themed brain teasers and puzzles to enhance critical thinking skills and encourage collaborative teamwork.
Photo Opps	A memorable activity where participants use themed props and/or custom backgrounds to document their learning experience.

Preschool to senior high school learners from public and private schools are invited to participate in this event to support their exposure and learning aligned with the current science curriculum.
