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35th NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE UP LIPUNANG PANGKASAYSAYAN

The University of the Philippines Lipunang Pangkasaysayan (UP LIKAS), an academic organization that promotes the critical and relevant study of history, as well as awareness of Filipino culture and society through various activities, will hold its 35th National Conference, titled *Handuraw: Pagsasakasaysayan ng Alaala at Paggunita*, at the UP School of Statistics Auditorium, UP Diliman, Quezon City, on November 10–11, 2026.

This year's Conference aims to provide wider knowledge and understanding of the history of memory and commemoration in the Philippines. It seeks to examine how individuals and communities remember, preserve, and reinterpret the nation's past and how these processes shape historical consciousness and collective identity. By exploring how historical figures, places, and events are remembered across different sectors of society, the activity encourages critical discussion of the relationship between memory, history, and historical truth.

High school and college learners and teachers nationwide are invited to participate in this event to promote critical thinking in the study of history. Interested participants may visit the UP LIKAS Facebook page for more information about the event.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2026, titled *Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education* and DO 9, s. 2005, titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
