INTERNATIONAL EQUILIBRIUM SCIENCE OLYMPIAD 2026

The Math Olympiads Training League Incorporated (MOTLI) invites learners from elementary through senior high school (Grades 1–12) in public and private schools to the International Equilibrium Science Olympiad (IESO) 2026. The Final Round (international/hybrid) will be held at Clark, Pampanga, on September 4–6, 2026.

The IESO is a global academic competition that promotes excellence in science while nurturing future thinkers, problem solvers, innovators, and responsible leaders. Guided by the Structure of Observed Learning Outcomes (SOLO) Taxonomy, the activity challenges learners through real-world scientific problems that deepen scientific understanding and develop higher-order thinking skills in Life Science, Physical Science, and Applied Science.

Specifically, the IESO aims to

- enhance scientific knowledge, inquiry skills, and experimental understanding;
- foster curiosity and innovation in scientific exploration and discovery;
- develop critical thinking and evidence-based reasoning in solving scientific problems; and
- promote global awareness and collaboration in addressing scientific and environmental issues.
