WORLD OF SCOUTING MUSEUM FOR OFF-CAMPUS ACTIVITIES

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Governance and Operations Strand, informs all regional directors, schools division superintendents, and school heads of the World of Scouting Museum that, in connection with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) Memorandum No. 49, s. 2026, the Regional Coordination Offices and Local Councils are to integrate museum visits into appropriate Scouting field activities.

Located on the Upper Ground Floor of Ayala Malls Circuit, Makati City, the Museum showcases the rich history and heritage of Philippine Scouting, its contributions to nationbuilding, and the Movement's lasting impact in shaping responsible citizens and community leaders. It also features the life and legacy of Lord Baden-Powell, the origins of the Scouting Movement, and the global fellowship that continues to unite millions of Scouts worldwide.

Consistent with DepEd's commitment to experiential learning and holistic learner development, schools may consider the World of Scouting Museum as a learning resource and an educational destination where the proposed visit is demonstrably relevant to the curriculum, learner formation, citizenship, leadership development, or other legitimate educational objectives.

Schools that elect to undertake such activity may coordinate directly with the World of Scouting Museum and/or the BSP for museum-related arrangements, only after or in accordance with the applicable DepEd approval processes. Any BSP requirements concerning museum tours, certificates, or merit badges shall be considered separate from, and shall not substitute for, DepEd requirements governing off-campus activities.

All regional offices and schools division offices are requested to disseminate this Advisory for the information and guidance of schools under their respective jurisdictions.

Participation of schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and Activities, and DO 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.

This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law).
