**3rd PHILARM BUILDING RESEARCH INNOVATION, DEVELOPMENT, AND GLOBAL
ENGAGEMENT FOR SUSTAINABILITY: RESEARCH MANAGEMENT TRAINING 2026
AND MARINDUQUE STATE UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE
ON SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE APPLICATIONS**

The Philippine Association of Research Managers (PHILARM) Inc. and Marinduque State University (MarSU) will host the 3rd PHILARM Building Research Innovation, Development, and Global Engagement for Sustainability (BRIDGES): Research Management Training (RMT) and the International Conference on Science, Technology, and Artificial Intelligence (ICSTAA) 2026 at MarSU in Boac, Marinduque, on November 18–21, 2026.

Envisioned as one of the country's premier multidisciplinary research gatherings, BRIDGES-ICSTAA 2026 aims to advance research excellence, innovation, ethical governance, and global engagement by bringing together researchers, research managers, faculty members, students, policymakers, government officials, industry leaders, and international collaborators across the research, education, technology, and development sectors.

The event will provide a comprehensive academic and professional platform featuring plenary sessions, research ethics training, workshops, research presentations, AI technology demonstrations, policy discussions, and networking opportunities that promote research excellence, innovation, ethical governance, and responsible research management.
