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AI-ASSISTED RESEARCH WITH INTEGRITY WORKSHOP SERIES

The Aloysian Publications, Center for the Promotion of Campus Journalism, and the World Association of Educators, Researchers, and Authors Inc. (WAERA) will conduct the AI-Assisted Research with Integrity: A 2-Part Intensive Hands-On Workshop for Graduate School Students and Institutional Researchers at the Manila Grand Opera Hotel, Sta. Cruz, Manila, with Module 1 (Research Proposal) on September 19–20, 2026, and Module 2 (Data Analysis, Results, and Conclusion) on October 3–4, 2026.

With the rapid evolution of generative artificial intelligence (AI) tools, such as ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, Elicit, and Scite, the workshop aims to provide participants with knowledge and practical guidance on the responsible and ethical use of AI in scholarly writing and data analysis.

Guided by international standards and best practices, participants will learn how to leverage AI responsibly as an intelligent “co-pilot” while maintaining a “human-in-the-loop” approach. By the end of the workshop series, delegates will be able to:

1. Master Ethical AI Prompt Engineering for literature synthesis, research gap identification, and theoretical framing while upholding academic integrity;
2. Draft Defense-Ready Proposals and Manuscripts (Chapters 1–5) in accordance with APA 7th Edition and international publication standards (IMRaD);
3. Utilize AI Tools for Data Analysis, including automated thematic analysis, statistical interpretation, and data visualization; and
4. Conduct Academic Integrity Audits using AI content detectors, similarity index tools (e.g., Turnitin and Grammarly), and formal AI disclosure protocols.
