16th NATIONAL CONVENTION ON STATISTICS

The Philippine Statistical System (PSS), through the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), is now accepting registrations for the 16th National Convention on Statistics (NCS), which will be held at The Manila Hotel, 1 Rizal Park, Ermita, Manila, on October 1-3, 2025.

This year's Convention will feature plenary sessions, invited and contributed paper sessions, poster sessions, panel discussions, statistical trainings, and the Statistical Information Management Exhibit. The event aims to

- a. provide a forum for practitioners and theoreticians in the field of statistics to discuss prevailing issues and emerging developments affecting the PSS; and
- b. elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe, and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

With the theme, Accelerating the SDG Pace of Progress: Mobilizing Data for All, the 16th NCS emphasizes the crucial role of data in assessing the country's progress in achieving Sustainable Development Goals. It also highlights the importance of improving the availability, accessibility, and use of data in accelerating the pace of progress and ensuring that no one shall be left behind.
