

SECURITY SERVICES AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Security Services Agreement made and entered into by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION-DIVISION OF BATANGAS**, with office address at Batangas Provincial Sports Complex, Bolbok, Batangas City, represented by its Schools Division Superintendent Head of Procuring Entity, **DR. MARITES A. IBAÑEZ**, herein after referred to as "CLIENT".

- and -

BATANGAS SEAL SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION SERVICE (**BSSIS**), **INC.**, a corporation duly organized and existing under Philippine laws with principal office at D. Silang Street, Barangay Cuta, Batangas City, represented by its OPERATIONS MANAGER, **JOEL D. MALALUAN, CSP**, hereafter referred to as "BSSIS".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the CLIENT is desirous in engaging the services of BSSIS for the purpose of securing, safeguarding, and protecting the officers, personnel, patrons, guests, and properties of the CLIENT located at Schools Division of Batangas-Batangas Provincial Sports Complex, Bolbok, Batangas City against theft, robbery, pilferage, arson, trespass, vandalism, and other criminal and/or unlawful acts, including the implementation of the CLIENT's policies, orders, rules, and regulations relative to the orderly maintenance of safety and security thereat.

WHEREAS, the BSSIS is engaged in rendering private security agency services throughout the Philippines and is duly licensed as such under Republic Act No. 5487 otherwise known as the "Private Security Agency Law" and has offered its services;

WHEREAS, BSSIS, representing itself as a duly and lawfully organized bonded, licensed, competent, and reliable security agency possessing the necessary capital, manpower, skills, and equipment, has offered its security services to secure, safeguard, and protect the CLIENT's officers, personnel, patrons, guests, and properties within the secured premises including the CLIENT's offices and other proprietary interests thereat.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties have agreed as they do hereby agree as follows:

1. BSSIS shall provide the CLIENT with **four (4)** duly licensed, trained, and uniformed security guards to perform **twelve (12)** hours security duty daily, including Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

- 2. It is understood and agreed upon that the guards to be furnished by BSSIS shall possess the qualifications as required by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Philippine National Police for security guard.
- 3. The CLIENT may, from time to time, request BSSIS for **additional guards**, when the exigency of the service so requires, provided that BSSIS is given at least TWENTY-FOUR (24) hours notice for the posting of additional guards.
- 4. BSSIS shall provide with guard in prescribed uniform and equipped with hand weapons required by the service, a 2-way hand-held radio communication and equipment and security metal detector.
 - 5. BSSIS shall provide the CLIENT guards with the following minimum qualifications, to wit:
 - 1. Filipino citizens with good moral character
 - 2. Has professional license of security guard
 - 3. High School graduate
 - 4. Age not below 25 years old but not more than 50 years old
 - 5. Clearances from Barangay, Police and NBI
 - 6. With adequate experience in security and allied services
 - 7. Must have passed the Polygraphic/Neuro Test and Drug Test under an accredited testing center
 - 8. Physically and mentally fit
- 6. The CLIENT shall every right to request for the **replacement of any security guard** supplied by BSSIS whose behavior, conduct, appearance, and/or performance is unsatisfactory to the CLIENT.
- 7. The client shall have the right to rescind, terminate or abrogate this contract in any of the following instances:
 - a. BSSIS having been found to have submitted a falsified license as well as other falsified documents.
 - b. BSSIS having found to fail to substantially fulfill its part of the contract.
 - 8. BSSIS shall assume responsibility for any loss or damage to the CLIENT's property provided that such loss or damage was duly accounted for by BSSIS in writing, placed in the possession or under the control of any BSSIS security guard, and the loss or damage occurred during such BSSIS security guard's tour of duty. In addition, it must be fully established, after due investigation, that said loss or damage was reported in writing to BSSIS within FORTY-EIGHT (48) hours from the occurrence of the loss or damage. In such case, nothing will prevent BSSIS from running after and holding accountable the person(s) actually responsible for such loss or damage. BSSIS assumes no responsibility for any loss or damage due to force majeure or fortuitous event or in case of any of the following conditions:





- a. Where the loss or damage occurred inside a closed or locked office, room, warehouse, or building wherein under normal conditions, the BSSIS security guard has no access;
- b. Where the property claimed to have been lost or damaged is kept in open space or storage, and was not duly turned over to BSSIS or its authorized representative for physical inventory and proper recording, or although not kept in an open space or storage, have been issued to the CLIENT's employee, agent, or any other person who is thus directly responsible for their use, care, and safekeeping;
- c. Where such loss or damage was the result of any or all of the following: robbery in band, mob violence, tumultuous affrays, acts of dissidents, war, insurrection, rebellion, revolution, demonstration, and/or rallies.
- 9. The CLIENT shall report in writing to BSSIS the occurrence of any compensable loss or damage to the CLIENT's properties within FORTY-EIGHT (48) hours after the occurrence thereof. The loss of or damage to the personal effects or properties of an individual officer, patron, guest, or employee is hereby excluded from the coverage of this Agreement.
- 10. Unless BSSIS accepts responsibility in writing, the CLIENT shall not deduct or offset any amount claimed for any compensable loss or damage with any billing or statement of account, the payment of which is collected by BSSIS for services rendered. However, once the liability for the loss or damage is established and accepted by BSSIS in writing, the CLIENT shall send a bill in writing to BSSIS for the value of the loss of damage less any depreciation or other allowable deductible expense.
- 11. BSSIS shall hold the CLIENT free and harmless from any liability, cause(s) of action, claim, or demand under any labor law, employment or collective bargaining agreement, or other special law, rules and regulations, which now or may hereafter be enacted, in which any BSSIS security guard or other employee may have against BSSIS by reason of their employment relations. It is understood that no employer-employee relations exists between the CLIENT and the employees of BSSIS.
- BSSIS, the CLIENT shall pay the rate of Forty One Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Eight Pesos and 69/100 Only (Php 41,978.69) for Night Shift duty, Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Three Pesos and 62/100 Only (Php 39,883.62) for Day Shift duty, Philippine currency, per month, on the basis of twelve (12) hours daily duty, including Sundays and holidays, Philippine currency, and an additional of one (1) day rate every month with 31 days (January, March, May, July, August, October and December) with a total of Nine Hundred Eighty Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty Seven Pesos and 72/100 Only (Php 982,347.72) for the period of January 01, 2025 to June 30, 2025.



- 13. BSSIS shall pay all the mandatory government contributions and allowances such as but not limited to SSS, Philhealth and Pag-ibig Contribution, Night Differential, 13th month pay and uniform allowance.
- 14. This Agreement shall take effect on **January 01, 2025** and shall be valid until **June 30, 2025**.
- 15. In case of litigation arising from or in relation to this Security Services Agreement, venue shall be exclusive to the proper courts of Batangas City only.
