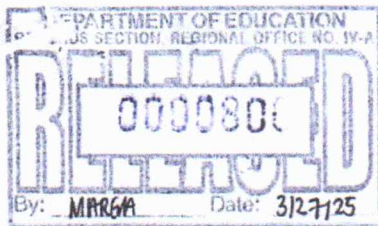

**DEVELOPMENT AND VALIDATION OF PISA LIKE
ASSESSMENT TOOL FOR GRADE 5 AND GRADE 8**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In line with the DepEd Order No. 8. s. 2015 "Policy Guidelines on Classroom Assessment for the K to 12 Basic Education Program," this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of the above-mentioned activities on May 27, 2025 at Bulwagan ng Karangalan DepEd IV-A Regional Office, and July 29 to August 1, 2025 at a venue to be announced through an advisory.
2. This activity aims to develop and validate a Contextualized Assessment Tool for Key Stages 2 and 3 focusing on Reading, Science, and Mathematics. By developing an assessment tool, educational goals and objectives can be conceptualized including the process of its delivery and its refinement towards an established system of assessment. In addition, the validated output of this activity will help orient, familiarize, and conceptualize the students and teachers of CALABARZON with the system of PISA to which the baseline on the quality of Reading, Science, and Mathematics education is being measured.
