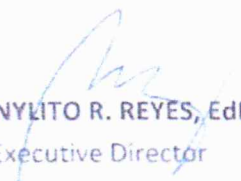

Project Background

Fun Fiesta sa Pilipinas was conceived September 2013 by Philippine Arts and Culture Educators Society in coordination Bulwagang Filipino Theatre Guild Inc as endorsed by the Department of Education through DepED Advisory 447 and 12 series of 2012/2013. Competition events were Folk dance, Contemporary interpretative dance, Chorale, Marching Band, Installation Art and Collage/Mosaic Art. There were at least twenty three [23] competing schools both in Elementary and Secondary category of the competition events representing DepED regions nationwide. Fun Fiesta sa Pilipinas 2013 was held at CSI Atrium Hall, City of San Fernando, Province of La Union.

Fun Fiesta Pilipinas ed Bangus Festival, 2nd National Performing Art Festival was held April 1-3, 2014 as the first major event in the opening of Dagupan City's Bangus Festival. DepED Advisory No. 507 series of 2014 was issued for the said activity. Department of Education Schools Division of Dagupan City co-hosted the event with the Local Government of Dagupan City. Forty Eight competing schools from different parts of the land participated both in the Elementary and Secondary category. Events include **Dance**: Folk dance and Contemporary Interpretative; **Theater**: One Act Play and Dance Drama; and **Music**: Chorale and Song Composition.

Fun Fiesta sa Pilipinas 2015, 3rd National Performing Arts Festival was held at Leandro Locsin Auditorium, NCCA Building, Gen. Luna Street, Intramuros, Manila and at University of Perpetual Help Dalta System, Las Pinas Campus. Annual competition was attended and participated by Sixty two competing schools nationwide vying for the top position in the Elementary and secondary category, It was indeed a great success in terms of evolution of dance and movement, choreography, voice simulation and other aesthetic values of the participating groups. Even without prize and cash incentives given still their enthusiasm to be part of the event was enormously felt and noticed.

The concluded, Fun Fiesta diay Dumayo Festival, 4th National Performing Arts festival held at Urdaneta City University Auditorium and at Urdaneta City Cultural and Sports Center from March 18 – 20, 2016. Actively participated Eighty Seven [87] schools nationwide. Events in **Dance** added Traditional Ethnic Ensemble and Hiphop; In **Music**, Marching Band and Rondalla included while in **Theater**, Chamber Theater and Monologue became part of the competition. Annual participation numbered to more or less Three hundred participants over the land.

Fun Fiesta sa Pilipinas 2017, 5th National Performing Arts Festival seek to embark on the progressive success of the first four events, magnify the events' most significant activities that drew a lot of participation from all contingents, so as to sustain the notable increase in the number of participating schools and its creative and artistic outputs, thus we were able to achieved the festival goal both in numbers and qualitative response of the annual national Performing Arts festival.

N F T S P L P N S 2018, 6th National Performing Arts Festival dreams to sustain the forthcoming event flying color and little extravagance compared to the previous affairs done. Hopefuls that we find a Local Government Unit and other National Government Agencies that will fully support this endeavor for the enrichment of our Young People's pride of their Cultural heritage, Dances, Music and Arts that form part of their embodiment as a Filipino.

N F T S P L P N S 2019, 7th National Performing Arts Festival exhort its simple yet extravagant presentation and hosting of the Local Government Unit of Tagudin, Ilocos Sur. From its conceptualization to the realization of the competition festival. Every department heads and staff was fully coordinated and in full cooperation and support to the success of the event. It was indeed a great success that paved a way to duplicate the amazing coordination with the Local Government.

School based performing arts groups can never be restrained in giving and sharing out their talents and skills inspite of the pandemic we experienced until the New Normal came out thus **N F T S P L P N S 2020 - 2022**, 8th to 10th National Performing Arts Festival Virtual Competition was conceptualized and realized through the

online and virtual platforms such as Google Meet, Zoom and Youtube live initially powered by the University of Perpetual Help System Dalta and other DepED school partners nationwide.

We still maintain the program's main purpose which is to promote, revive, re-invent and strengthen our culture as Filipino, and encourage the young generation to embrace our native dance, music and songs to re-establish our own identity. We will also continue to motivate our learners to initiate unto themselves the discovery of their artistic talents and aesthetic values. In so doing, we intend to make this event more challenging with some innovations and additional activities.

Realizing our aim entails also progressive challenge of funding the event. One thing that will add to our funding requirements is to proposed for prizes and cash incentives, which we did not provide during the first five National Performing Arts Festival. Other than the clamour by the participants, we intend to give these prizes to entice more regional, divisions and schools to participate. Subsidies on transportation expenses, one of the biggest components of each contingents expense, is also a main concern. With our past experiences, although we extended our effort in soliciting sponsors, we still came short and which resulted to backing off out of some of our national finalist mostly those who are about to compete from farthest place of delegation.

Video Pre-Screening of the regional Competition to be accomplished by submission of acceptable video formats of the contestant's performance enclosed to PACES Secretariat Office, Blk 62, Lot 2, Marigold corner Bay Drive, Road 40, Robinsons Homes East Subdivision, San Jose, Antipolo City and must be received on or before September 30, 2025. Those successfully pass this round will be declared as National Finalist.

Stage Three

National final Competition will be held at Municipality of Roxas, Isabela wherein the National Finalists shall compete for the top position.

The competition is open to all recognized school based performing arts groups in the Philippines. PACES individual members are encouraged to join the competition.
