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appropriate technical experts, former champions, and resource persons, and to implement a structured training program that will further enhance the skills and performance of the qualifiers.

5. Meanwhile, only the Overall Top 5 Best School Papers winners in school paper events in elementary and secondary levels will be sent to the 2026 NSPC for the exhibit of best school papers.
6. This Office extends highest appreciation to Rizal Cluster as the host of this edition of the RSPC including host private schools and colleges and Municipal and Local Government Units.
