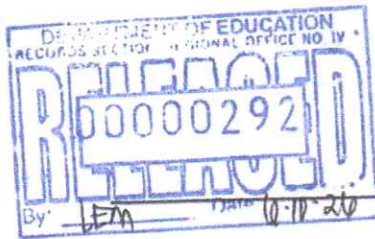

**PRECAUTIONARY AND PREPAREDNESS MEASURES FOR
THE ONSET OF THE RAINY SEASON 2026**

To : **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In line with the RDRRMC Memorandum No. 84, s. 2026¹ and Memorandum No. 88, s. 2026², consistent with the Department's commitment to safety and preparedness, this Office reiterates the guidelines on school-based preparedness, class suspensions, and the reporting system during weather disturbances.
2. This Memorandum aims to ensure the preparedness of personnel and learners for the onset of weather disturbances during the rainy season. Accordingly, school heads and Schools Division Offices are directed to strictly adhere to the following Department and Regional Office issuances for guidance and compliance:
 - a) DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2026 – Guidelines on Learning Continuity in Emergencies;
 - b) DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2024 – Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspensions in Schools During Disasters and Emergencies;
 - c) DepEd Order No. 033, s. 2021 – School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response Measures for Tropical Cyclones, Flooding, and Other Weather-Related Disturbances and Calamities; and
 - d) Regional Memorandum No. 49, s. 2026 – Implementation of the DRRMS Incident Management Reporting System (IMRS)
