STATUS OF COMPLIANCE TO FY 2022 PERFORMANCE-BASED

BONUS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND AGENCY ACCOUNTABILITIES

As announced in DM-OUHROD-2024-0736 titled *Final Validation Results for the FY 2022 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) and Preparation of Form 1.0*, the Department of Education was deemed eligible for the grant of the FY 2022 PBB by the AO 25 Inter-Agency Task Force Technical Working Group (AO25 IATF TWG).

However, since the Department did not meet the targets in 2 out of 4 eligibility criteria and was non-compliant in 3 out of 11 agency accountabilities, the grant of the FY 2022 PBB shall not be automatic and shall be guided by *Item 6.0 - Guidelines on the Eligibility of Delivery Units and Individuals* in Memorandum Circular 2022-1, to wit:

- 6.1.1 ...In case the agency fails to meet a rating of 4 in at least three (3) criteria, the unit/s most responsible (including its head) for the criteria stated in Section 3.0 with a performance rating of below 4 will be isolated from the grant of the FY 2022 PBB.
- 6.1.2 The unit/s most responsible (including its head) for the non-compliance with the Agency Accountabilities provided in Section 5.0 shall also be isolated from the grant of the FY 2022 PBB.









Thus, there will be isolation for the grant of the FY 2022 PBB due to the non-accomplishment of any eligibility criteria and/or non-compliance with any agency accountability based on the Agency Scorecard provided by the AO25:

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Based on reports from validating agencies [AO25, Department of Budget and Management (DBM), 8888 Citizens' Complaint Center and Contact Center ng Bayan (CCB), and Government Procurement Policy Board-Technical Support Office (GPPB-TSO)] and PBB focal offices in DepEd CO, the FY 2021–2023 National Performance Management Team decided on the units/positions to be isolated from the grant of the FY 2022 PBB, as required by the AO25.

As a result, Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendents from ROs and SDOs with non-accomplished targets and/or non-compliant accountabilities shall be isolated from the grant of the FY 2022 PBB.

Attached is the final Status of Compliance for your respective Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices under your jurisdiction. The said list shall be the basis of the AO25 for the FY 2022 PBB payout of non-school-based personnel.

In view of the foregoing, the Regional Office – Performance Management Team (RO-PMT) is requested to submit the updated Form 1.0 to the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development – Personnel Division (BHROD-PD) through email at pbb.secretariat@deped.gov.ph on or before 29 November 2024.
